To minimise the impact of this The O2 have worked closely with TfL to provide additional transport services should the show over run after the last Jubilee Line service at 00:16 into Central London. The last eastbound Jubilee Line service (Stratford) is at 01:04. Please read the transport information below to help with your journey home.

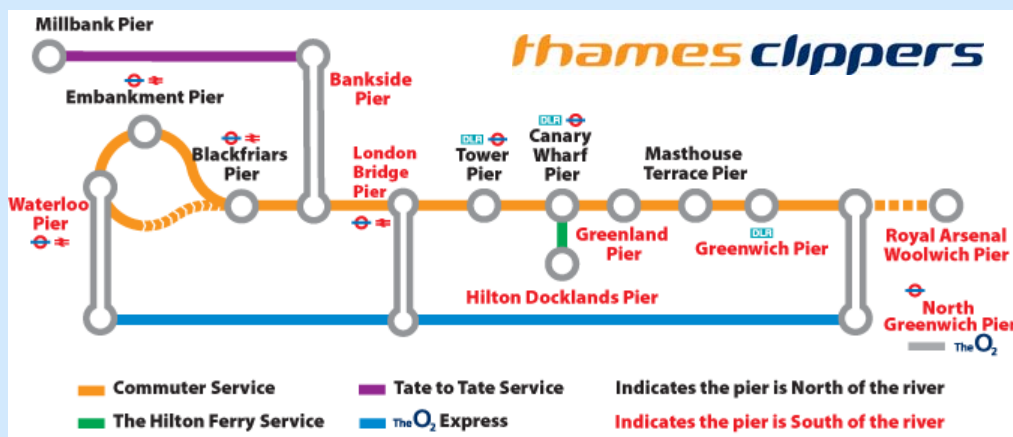

by train

southeastern.

Southeastern trains operate between Charlton, north Kent and London. Charlton mainline is the closest railway station to The O2 and served by eight trains per hour.

Should the show over run beyond the last tube services a **FREQUENT FREE REPLACEMENT BUS SERVICE** will run every 5 minutes (until 01:30) to Charlton station from The O2 (8 minute bus ride). Additional train services will also be provided to connect with Lewisham, Charing Cross, Waterloo East and London Bridge (approx. 20 minute journey).

The routes and pick up points will be clearly signed by The O2 stewards, bus and station staff. Oystercard will be accepted on the train services. For service information please visit www.southeasternrailway.co.uk to plan your journey.

Eight TfL local bus routes operate to and from The O2. Key destinations include Stratford, Charlton, Greenwich, Lewisham, Woolwich, Eltham, North Kent and central London. 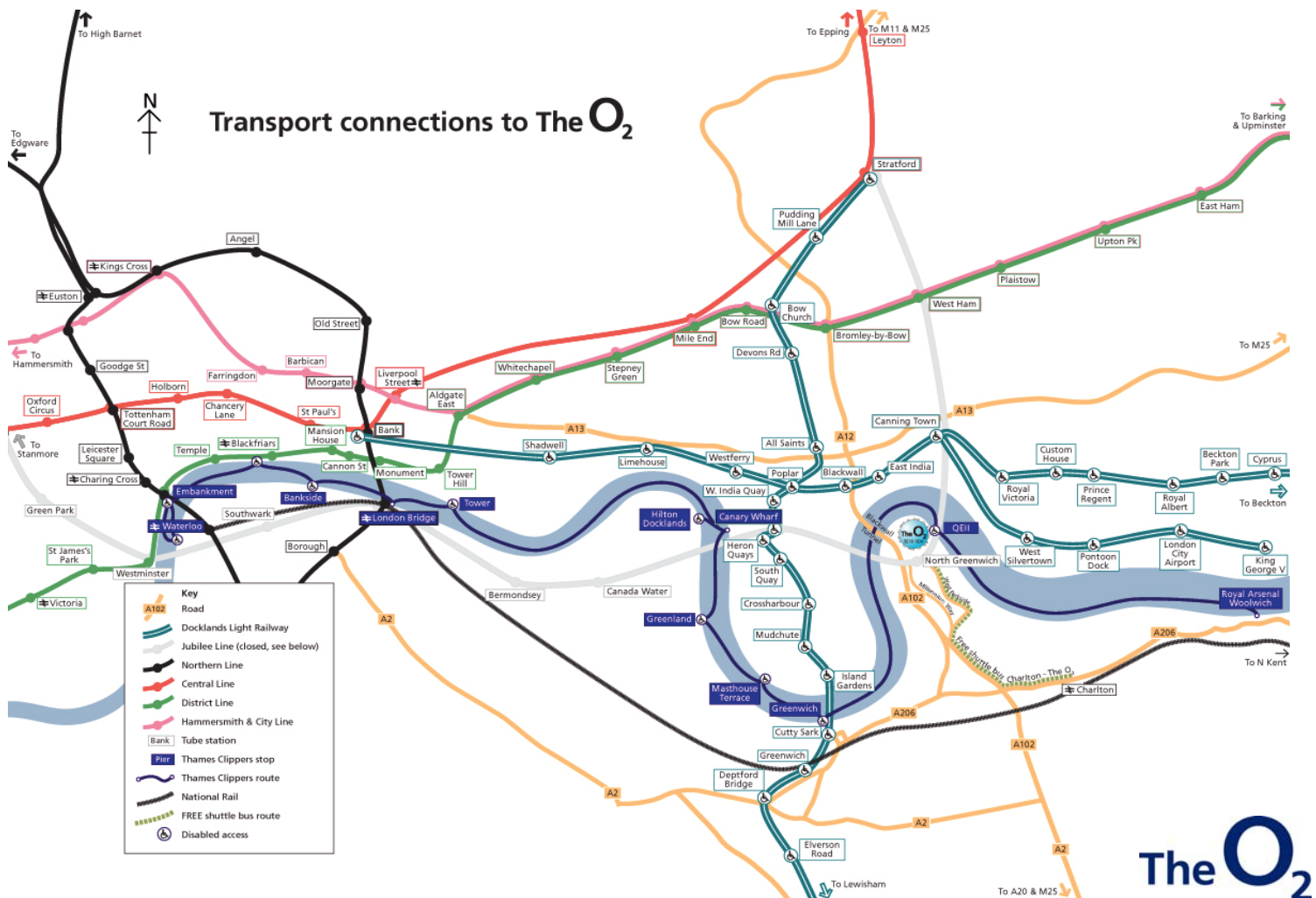
